The regular monthly meeting for the Town of New Holstein was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman, Gary Winkler.

Members present: Gary Winkler, Dean Konen, Ben Henke, Mary Jo Muellenbach, and Cheryl Heller, also present was Nick Brownson.

The pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

A motion to accept the agenda was made by Dean Konen seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the minutes as read, from the May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Town Board meeting was made by Ben Henke seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

A motion to approve the monthly treasurers' report as presented was made by Ben Henke seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the June bills for payment, and to include payment for Halquist Stone, was made by Ben Henke seconded by Dean Konen, carried 3-0.

Road Supervisors report: Nick reported ditch mowing has started, and they have been getting roads ready for paving.

A motion was made by Dean Konen to replace the culvert on Tecumseh Rd. not to exceed \$9200 it was seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

A motion to approve Class B Liquor and Class B beer License applications for The Outdoors, Schwarz's' Supper Club and Seven Corners Bar and to approve temporary Class B beer license for St Anna Sportsman's club, for the 50 bird shoot on 7/18/20, and the Turkey shoot on 8/23/20 and all operators licenses as read was made by Dean Konen seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

Action on lawn mower replacement was tabled until July.

Dean Konen: Reported Northeast asphalt will begin pulverizing on 6/15/20 and paving on 6/22/20. He also issued 2 driveway permits.

Ben Henke: Reported on the tractor purchase, delivery to the Town should be mid Aug. – mid Sept.

Cheryl Heller: No Report

Mary Jo Muellenbach: Reported on large item recyclables being dumped in garbage bins. Mary Jo also reported we received the recycling grant for \$9116.41 & the consolidation grant for \$382.14
