The regular monthly meeting for the Town of New Holstein was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman, Ben Henke.

A motion to accept the agenda was made by Ben Henke seconded by Len Heimerman and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the minutes as read, from the June 9th 2021 Town Board meeting was made by Dean Konen seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

A motion to approve the monthly treasurers' report as presented was made by Len Heimerman seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the July bills for payment, was made by Len Heimerman seconded by Dean Konen, carried 3-0.

Public Comment: Lee and Alex from Dempsey Law firm gave a brief introduction of themselves and their firm.

A motion to name Dempsey Law firm the official legal representation for the Town of New Holstein was made by Dean Konen seconded by Len Heimerman and carried unanimously.

A motion made by Dean Konen to have Calumet county install sign posts and signs for the ATV & weight limit signs not to exceed \$5000; was seconded by Len Heimerman and carried 3-0.

Ben Henke made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2021-02 Manure Distribution Equipment Permit it was seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

Discussed purchase order system, no action was needed.

A motion to adopt Resolution 2021-01 ARPA Fund, was made by Ben Henke seconded by Len Heimerman and carried 3-0.

A motion to approve a Temporary class B beer license and an operator's license for the St. Anna Church picnic was made by Ben Henke seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

Dean Konen: discussed culvert permits, road repair schedule and weed spraying.

Len Heimerman: Reported Nick will be removing the 2 dead trees on the property. He also reported Nick said the mower is working well.

Cheryl Heller: No Report

Mary Jo Muellenbach: Reported on the ongoing garbage and recycling pick up issues.
