From Mike Schlaak County Treasurer:

Town of New Holstein residents were assigned approx \$68,000 less tax levy in 2013 than necessary, causing the mill rate to be approx. 61 cents per thousand less.

As a result, Town residents will be assigned this difference as part of the 2014 tax levy. Therefore the tax rate will likely see an increase of approx. \$1.22 as a result (all other things constant).

- New or change in existing driveways and culverts.

TOWN ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS AND DITCHES:

- Nothing is to be planted within 33 feet of either direction of town road centerline.
- Ditches are not to be used to dump stones or to push excess snow into.
- No alterations or changes in depth or contour of any ditch or embankment of any town road within the town road right-of-way.
