**Town of New Holstein Resolution Supporting the 2045 Calumet County
Comprehensive Plan Update**

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin requires counties, cities, villages, and towns that engage in zoning, subdivision regulation, or official mapping to adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in § 66.1001, Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, Calumet County and the partnering municipalities of the City of Brillion, the Villages of Hilbert and Potter, and the Towns of Brillion, Brothertown, Charlestown, Chilton, New Holstein, Rantoul, and Woodville, have undertaken the process to create one cohesive comprehensive plan to guide future land use, development, preservation, and community services throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the 2045 Comprehensive Plan establishes a vision and framework for future growth and development that balances agricultural preservation, natural resource protection, and rural character with the need for housing, economic development, and infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Town of New Holstein has actively participated in the comprehensive planning process through public meetings, working group sessions, and content review, in coordination with the participating municipalities; and

WHEREAS, although the Town of New Holstein is not required by statute to adopt the 2045 Comprehensive Plan by ordinance, the Town Board desires to formally express its support for the updated Comprehensive Plan;

WHEREAS, The final version of the *Calumet County 2045 Comprehensive Plan* can be found on the Calumet County website at: <https://calumetcounty.org/183/Comprehensive-Planning>, and at the Calumet County Planning, Zoning, and Land Information Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of New Holstein hereby supports and endorses the 2045 Calumet County Comprehensive Plan update and encourages its consideration and uses as a guide for land use decisions within Calumet County.




