A motion to accept the agenda was made by Ben Henke seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the minutes with clarification Ben will contact Andre Jacques, from the August 12th, 2020 Town Board meeting was made by Dean Konen seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

A motion to approve the monthly treasurers' report as presented was made by Ben Henke seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the September bills for payment was made by Dean Konen seconded by Ben Henke, carried 3-0.

Road Supervisors report: Nick said he started 3rd round mowing, and shouldering was complete. He also said culverts are paved.

There was public input about ATV & UTV ordinances. The town is looking to get more feedback from townspeople to see if they are interested in having ATV's & UTV's on town roads, and from the state about ordinances to make sure that if it is done, it is done legally.

A motion was made by Ben Henke to make repairs to the heating system in December not to exceed \$900 it was seconded by Dean Konen and carried 3-0.

A motion to have a large item pick up event again this year was made by Dean Konen seconded by Ben Henke and carried 3-0.

Dean Konen made a motion to accept the recycling resolution presented by Mary Jo Muellenbach, Ben Henke seconded and it carried 3-0.
