ORDINANCE NO. 2012-2

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO THE CALUMET COUNTY YEAR
2025 SMART GROWTH PLAN AND THE TOWN OF NEW HOLSTEIN EXPANDED
LAND USE ELEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of New Holstein, Calumet County, Wisconsin, as follows:

Section 1: Section 66.1001(2)(I), Wisconsin Statutes, states that a comprehensive plan shall be updated no less than once every 10 years.

Section 2: The Calumet County Planning, Zoning and Land Information Department conducted a 5-year update to coincide with the release of the 2010 U.S. Census.

Section 3: The plan amendments include, but are not limited to: text, table, chart and map amendments to reflect available updated statistical and factual data, updates to land use and service matters, and *identification of accomplishments achieved in the Implementation/Action* section of the town's land use element.

Section 4: The Town Board of the Town of New Holstein held a public hearing on May 16, 2012 to review and amend the *Calumet County Year 2025 Smart Growth Plan* and the *Town of New Holstein Expanded Land Use Element*.

Section 5: The Town Board of the Town of New Holstein does, by the enactment of this Ordinance, formally adopts the amended *Calumet County Year 2025 Smart Growth Plan* and the *Town of New Holstein Expanded Land Use Element* pursuant to Section 66.1001(4)©, Wisconsin Statutes. Note: with exception to the County and Town considering the jurisdictional transfer of Highway T.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Town Board and publication/posting as required by law.




