Ordinance No. 2021-1

CLASS B HIGHWAY WEIGHT LIMITS

The Town Board of the Town of New Holstein do ordain as follows:

Section 1: CLASS B HIGHWAY WEIGHT LIMITS

- A. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 349.15(2), the Town hereby designates as class “B” highways and imposes those weight limitations set forth in Wis. Stat. § 348.16 upon the following Town highways:
 - 1. All Town highways.
- B. The Town shall cause the appropriate traffic signage to be placed upon the above-designated highways.
- C. Wis. Stat. §§ 348.16 & 348.21 are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance by reference as if fully set forth herein, and as from time to time amended.
- D. Any violator of this Ordinance is subject to any one or any combination of the following penalties:
 - 1. A forfeiture in the amount of not less than \$50 and not more than \$500.
 - 2. A forfeiture in an amount calculated according to Wis. Stat. § 348.21.
 - 3. Court-imposed injunctive relief to enjoin further violations.
- E. Upon conviction for a violation of this Ordinance, a violator shall also pay all applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs as allowed by law.
- F. Each trip upon each designated class “B” highway in violation of this Ordinance constitutes a separate offense.
- G. Application may be made to the Town Board for a permit to allow trip(s) in excess of the weight limitations hereby imposed upon an application and the

payment of a fee for the consideration of such permit as determined by the Town Board.

Section 2: If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is found invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provision or application of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they would prevent or hinder any operation of this Ordinance as written.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of adoption and notice to the public as required by law.


Section 5: Town officers and personnel are hereby authorized and directed to take all further actions necessary in order to enact this Ordinance.
