RESOLUTION to SUPPORT CONSOLIDATION RECYCLING EFFICIENCY GRANT

WHEREAS, the Town of New Holstein, Calumet County, Wisconsin, is eligible to seek financial assistance under the Recycling Consolidation Grant, Section 287.24, of the Wisconsin State Statutes: and

WHEREAS the Town of New Holstein is qualified to carry out the responsibilities of recycling efficiency by combining resources with the East Shore Recycling Commission to complete one or more elements of an effective recycling program as defined in Section 287.11 of the Wisconsin State Statutes: and

WHEREAS in this action the Town Board declares its intent to conduct an efficient recycling project described in the grant application.

IT IS, THEREFORE, RESOLVED THAT: the Town of New Holstein, requests the funds and assistance available from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources under the Recycling Consolidation Grant Program: and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES the treasurer, Mary Jo Muellenbach to act on behalf of the Town of New Holstein to: submit an application to the State of Wisconsin for financial aid for recycling purposes: sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete an approved recycling consolidation grant project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Town of New Holstein will meet the obligations of the Recycling Consolidation Grant project. We understand the importance of continuing the recycling.
