Ordinance No. 2024-2

SNOWMOBILE ACCESS

The Town Board of the Town of New Holstein do ordain as follows:

Section 1: SNOWMOBILE ACCESS.

A. Purpose.

Under Wis. Stat. § 350.18(3)(a) this Ordinance allows the operation of snowmobiles on a roadway and/or shoulder of a highway for any portion of a highway that lies within the boundaries of the Town for the purpose of residential access, and/or for the purpose of access from lodging, to or from the nearest snowmobile route or trail.

B. State law incorporated.

Wis. Stat. ch. 350 on snowmobiles, including but not limited to definitions, rules of operation, and penalties for violation, are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance by reference and as from time to time it is amended.

C. Required conditions.

The following are additional required conditions for the operation of snowmobiles as allowed under this Ordinance:

1. The operation of snowmobiles under this Ordinance is only allowed during such periods of time that the County has declared that snowmobile trails are open.
2. Snowmobiles shall be operated on the extreme right side of the roadway and travel with the flow of traffic.
3. Multiple snowmobiles are to be operated in single file.
4. A snowmobile's headlights and taillights shall be operated at all times.
5. Snowmobile operators shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicular traffic and to pedestrians.

D. Notification.

The Town Clerk shall send a copy of this enacted Ordinance to the County Sheriff's Department and to the Department of Natural Resources.

E. Enforcement.

This Ordinance may be enforced by the Town, by the designee of the Town Board, the County Sheriff's Department, and any other agency with law enforcement jurisdiction within the boundaries of the Town.

Section 2: If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is found invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the provision or application of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they would prevent or hinder any operation of this Ordinance as written.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of adoption and notice to the public as required by law.

Section 5: Town officers and personnel are hereby authorized and directed to take all further actions necessary in order to enact this Ordinance.
